

Through the provision of this environment your child will develop an understanding of the need to respect and tolerate others, sharing and co-operation.



Baby Rooms

Above all, babies are provided with lots of cuddles, laughter and TLC!

Our Baby rooms are separate, secure and safe, designed to offer the highest possible care and attention for even the youngest of babies.

We maintain a welcoming environment, offering a professional approach and providing a stimulating, enjoyable day at nursery for the children.

We offer a variety of activities from messy play and painting to nursery rhymes, action songs and music. The babies have a variety of suitable toys, and sensory areas are created to stimulate and enjoy.

Babies enjoy our specially designed gardens and regularly participate in carefully supervised outings. Above all, all babies are provided with lots of cuddles, laughter and TLC!

Staff in the baby rooms are qualified and experienced in the care of young babies and are always available to discuss your child's needs.



Tweeny

Our Tweeny areas cater for children up to the age of 2 years and provide a caring, stimulating environment for your child to develop his/her skills.

Our qualified staff provide your child with a varying curriculum to enable them to experience and explore a variety of activities. Singing and finger rhymes, stories and books develop their language and listening skills, whilst art and craft, paint, sand and water, music and dance develop creative minds.

Other activities include Duplo, Lego and bead-threading, shape and colour sorting, construction toys, and pencil control, pre-number, pre-writing and fine motor skills.

Topics are based on everyday activities and help the children's understanding of the world in which they live. Encouraging their independence helps to develop their personal and social skills.

The children have every opportunity for outside play, whether in the grounds or on various outings, where they will build upon the physical skills they are rapidly acquiring.

The staff are always available to discuss your child's progress and provide a variety of activities to develop their skills in all areas.

We aim to make your child's time at nursery enjoyable and fun whilst combining an education program within a structured day.

Our Inbetweeny areas cater for children over 2 and up to pre-school age (approx 3). During their time in this group, children enjoy many fun activities designed to explore and expand their rapidly developing skills.

Our qualified staff help the Inbetweenies learn about the world in which they live, encouraging each child to become more independent and develop the necessary social skills to be happy in later life.

Creative skills are developed through art & craft activities, sand & water play and by exploring the world of music with a specialist teacher.

Language & pre-reading skills develop rapidly with plenty of opportunities to listen to and discuss various books.

Topics such as 'ourselves' & 'methods of transport' are introduced both in the nursery and whilst on trips to places of interest around the island.





Pre-school

The Pre-school department provides opportunities for the children aged 3 to 5 years to access the six areas of learning. These are designed to encourage their all-round development.

The six areas of learning are:-

Knowledge and understanding of the world

Creative development

Physical development

Mathematical development

Personal and Social development

Language and Literacy

We provide the children with a structured curriculum and planned activities to ensure they will be able to work towards achieving the Early Learning Goals.

Significant elements of development are as follows:

Physical development

- gross and fine motor skills

Mathematical development

- using and applying numbers

Personal and Social development

- relate personal and social development to all areas of learning

Language and Literacy

- speaking and listening
- reading and writing

The children have a variety of equipment including computers, musical instruments, home corner, books, construction toys, manipulative toys, sand and water, painting and collage, bicycles and climbing frames, to enable them to develop all their skills within the areas of learning to achieve the Early Learning Goals.

All these areas of development can only evolve in a structured, warm, caring environment which our qualified Pre-school staff provide for all children.

Staff & Training

Staff and management at La Petite École are dedicated to providing caring and quality childcare.

All permanent staff are qualified in childcare or working towards a recognised childcare qualification.

All qualified staff are required to perform Continuing Professional Development.

La Petite École provides an in-house training facility to ensure good practice throughout our nurseries and to compliment the courses provided by the authorities.

It is a requirement for staff to undertake training in:

- Basic Food Hygiene
- First Aid
- Child Protection
- Blood Borne virus awareness





Settling In

Whilst every care is taken to ensure our nurseries always provide a warm and welcoming environment, we do undersand that the first days at nursery are always a big step for any child.

We ask that all children have a settling in period. This is usually over a period of two to three weeks, depending on the age and stage of development of the child, and will require the attendance of a parent or guardian.

This is a vital part of the development process to ensure that the transition between home and nursery is smooth, and benefits all concerned, the staff, parents and most importantly your child.

System

A Key Worker system is in place, where your child will be allocated a member of staff to cater for their everyday needs. They will also form a special relationship with both child and parent.

If you have any questions or queries, you can go to your Key Worker for advice. If the Key Worker is not available, a co-worker is allocated to ensure that relevant information is passed on to parents and carers.



Within the fee structure, the nursery provides a well balanced diet and can cater for any dietary needs or requests.

All of the children's meals are freshly prepared with carefully planned menus to ensure a healthy, well-balanced diet and special diets are catered for.

For Breakfast we provide a choice of toasts, spreads, cereals and fruit.

Lunch is a full meal consisting of a variety of food groups including pasta, meats, fish, rice, vegetables, vegetarian, and desserts.

We also provide a cooked afternoon meal or light tea, including children's favourites such as sandwiches or spaghetti.

At snack times, the children will enjoy a variety of fresh fruit, vegetables and crackers.

Our menus follow a five-weekly rotation and are clearly displayed within the nurseries.

Activities

At La Petite École we feel it is important that all children have the opportunity to experience a wide and varied curriculum. In addition to the daily varied routine, the children have access to a whole host of extra activities.

We teach French to Pre-school children and provide swimming lessons prior to starting school. Our experienced dance teacher provides dance and movement sessions for all children. We also have a music teacher, who plays lots of well-known favourites as well as songs relating to the world around us.

Being located near to many beaches gives us the opportunity for picnics on the beach (building sand castles and collecting shells) as well as outings to Zoos and Parks. All outings of any distance are made in the nursery mini bus, which fully complies with safety guidelines.

Throughout the year, we have many events which are always hugely successful, fun and well supported.


